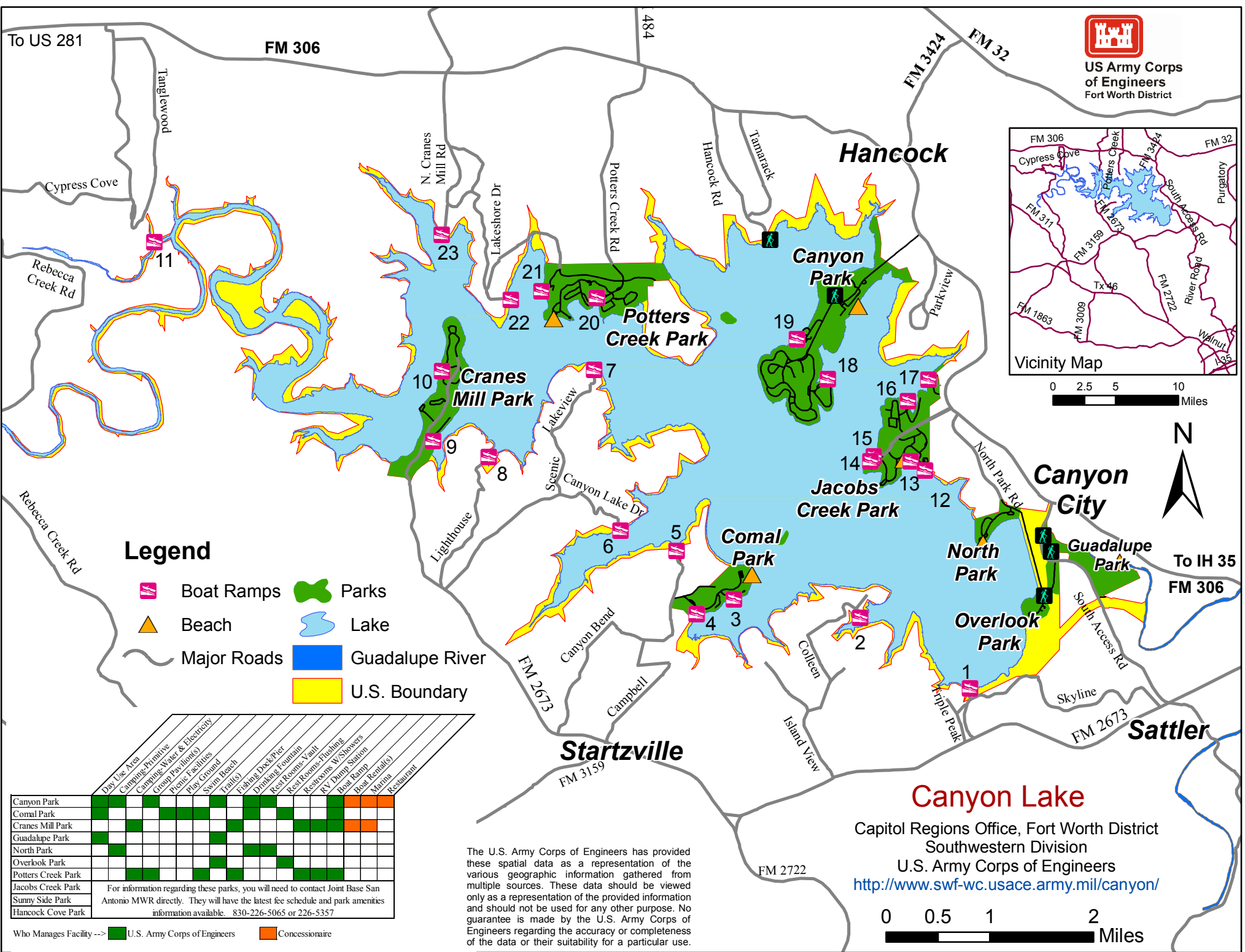
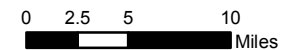
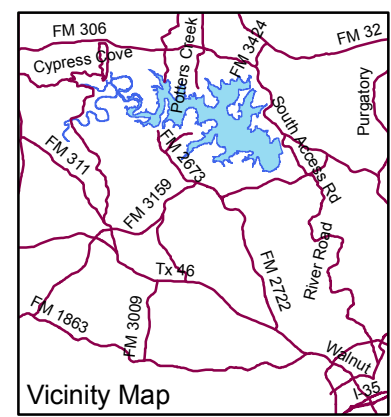

### **Potters Creek Park**

**Season:** All year    **Hours:** 8 AM – 10 PM daily  
**Fees:** 109 RV Sites (electricity & water) - \$26/night  
4 Family Sites (3 RV Sites)    \$60/night  
1 Family Site (2 RV Sites)    \$40/night  
7 Screened Shelters    \$40/night  
10 Tent Sites    \$20/night  
Group pavilion    \$100/day

**Amenities:** Electricity & water at all camp sites, boat ramps, showers, flush toilets, picnic tables with awnings, cook grills, fire ring, dump stations

### **Cranes Mill Park**

**Season:** All year    **Hours:** 8 AM – 10 PM daily  
**Fees:** 30 RV Sites    \$26/night  
34 Tent Sites    \$20/night

**Amenities:** Electricity & water at all sites, boat ramp, showers, flush toilets, dump station, fishing pier, picnic tables with awnings, cook grills, fire ring.

### **Canyon Park**

**Season:** 01 Apr – 30 Sept    **Hours:** 8 AM – 10 PM daily  
**Fees:** 150 Tent Only Campsites    \$12/night  
Group Pavilions (2 overnight)    \$75/night  
Group Pavilions (1 day use)    \$75/day

**Amenities:** Tables, fire rings, water fountains, boat ramp, vault toilets. No RV hookups. No showers.

### **North Park**

**Season:** 01 Apr- 30 Sep  
**Hours:** 9 AM – 10 PM Friday and Saturday  
9 am to 2 pm Sunday. Closed Monday-Thursday  
**Fees:** 19 Tent sites (no RV hookups)    \$12/night  
**Amenities:** Tables, fire rings, water fountains, vault toilets.

**ALERT!** No showers. No boat ramp. No beach.  
No camping RVs, 5<sup>th</sup> wheels, or pop-ups allowed!

### **Campsite Capacity Rules:**

Maximum of 10 persons per single-use campsite (including visitors). Maximum of 2 camping units per single-use campsite (1 RV+1 tent, 1 trailer+1 tent, 2 tents). Maximum of 2 vehicles/campsite for overnight occupancy (does not include recreational unit). Maximum 2 extra vehicles/campsite between 8 a.m. – 10 p.m. Vehicles = anything that takes up a parking space. This includes boats, RVs, pop-ups, trucks and cars. Vehicles with visitor passes must exit the park by 10 p.m.  
\*Cranes Mill Tent sites may have a maximum of 3 vehicles that stay over night

### **Day Use Park Usage Permit**

Visitors holding a valid day use permit may enter another day use park managed by USACE on the same day without paying additional charges. They may not enter a camping park without paying the FULL CAMPING FEE. Payment of a day use fee cannot be applied toward the purchase of a camping permit.

### **ANNUAL DAY USE PASSES (ADUP)**

- A. Available for purchase at a cost of \$40.
- B. Vehicles with ADUP will be admitted to **day use** parks at no charge (*Must present ADUP on entry*)
- C. ADUP accepted at all **Day-Use Parks** managed by U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
- D. ADUP accepted for one year from the date of purchase

### **AMERICA THE BEAUTIFUL PASS PROGRAM**

Passes may be obtained through parks at Canyon Lake. Call the main office during business hours to verify which parks currently carry the pass you wish to acquire.

#### **\*\* PARK CAPACITIES\*\***

LIMITS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED: ONCE THE MAXIMUM CAPACITY IS REACHED, A PARK WILL BE CLOSED FOR THE DAY UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

### **10 Minute Drive-Thru:**

Camping parks only: Canyon, Cranes Mill, Potters Creek  
No drive-thru allowed in day use Parks.  
Monday thru Thursday during daylight hours.  
Restricted: Fri./Sat./Sun., holidays, and when park is full.

### **Outside Bikers and Walkers:**

**NOT** allowed in any gated park unless you are a registered camper or have paid the associated day use fee(s). Must retain your receipt to show you paid if stopped by a Ranger. Madrone Trail users in Canyon Park must stay on the trail and not use roads or campsites.

### **Overlook Park (Day Use Only)**

**Season:** All year  
**Hours:** 7 AM – Sunset  
**Fees:** None  
**Amenities:** Scenic walking trails through the woods and along shore line, public restroom, and lake office.  
NO alcohol allowed in park. No glass containers allowed.

### **Guadalupe Park (Day Use Only)**

**Season:** All year  
**Hours:** open 24hrs for fishing  
**Fees:** None  
**Amenities** North side of river: concrete sidewalk trail to fishing platform near power plant.  
South side of river: Scenic walking trail, fishing access.

### **Canyon Park Beach (Day Use Only)**

**Season:** Open 01 Apr – 30 Sep  
**Hours:** Open 8 AM - Sunset Sat, Sun & Holidays;  
1 PM - Sunset Mon-Fri  
**Fees:**  
Drive ups: \$5/vehicle (no boats/trailers allowed)  
Walk-In or Bike-In: \$2/per person  
--Age 16 and older pay walk up fee.  
--Age 15 and under do not pay walk up fees.  
--FREE to Registered campers.  
**Amenities:** Beach, restroom, picnic tables, grills.  
No pets, glass containers, or trailers allowed.

### **Comal Park (Day Use Only)**

**Season:** 01 Apr – 30 Sept  
**Hours:** 8 AM – Sunset  
**Fees:**  
Drive ups: \$5/vehicle  
Walk-In or Bike-In: \$2/per person  
--Age 16 and older pay walk up fee.  
--Age 15 and under do not pay walk up fees.  
--FREE to Registered campers.  
**Amenities:** 55 picnic sites, grills, swim beach, restroom, horse shoe pits, and playground. No pets or glass allowed in beach area.
